Our main barn and covered riding arena were completed in November of 2023, the round pen in December of 2023, septic, water lines, and stalls in June of 2024 and all the while we've remained functional in providing sessions.

We now excitedly need your help to finish outfiting the facility with everything it needs to be a welcoming haven for children, families, and young adults needing to experience hope and healing.

PHASE 3 - FINISHING

Needed by

The Final Phase of the UNIMPOSSIBLE project involves the "finishing" of our Forever Home as we continue to operate and involves the need for items or services to be donated or the funding to purchase the following:

- o 600 10' round poles or rough cedar logs for buck and rail fencing \$10,800
- o 2008" carriage bolts and locking nuts for buck and rail fencing \$2,100
- o 3 20' culverts \$1000
- 50 bags of Kentucky 31 Tall Fescue grass seed \$6,000
- LED lighting installed in covered riding arena TBD (in bid process as of 7/1/24)
- \circ Power outfitted to the shedrow barn TBD (in bid process as of 7/1/24)
- Agricultural ceiling fan and installation \$6,000
- Tornado Shelter and installation \$18,000
- Parking lot finishing: (smaller rock/quarter down): \$8,000
- Quarantine/isolation paddock: \$15,500 (Footing/grading: \$6000, Building: \$4,500, Fencing: \$2000, Stall Mats: \$1000, Labor: \$2000)
